

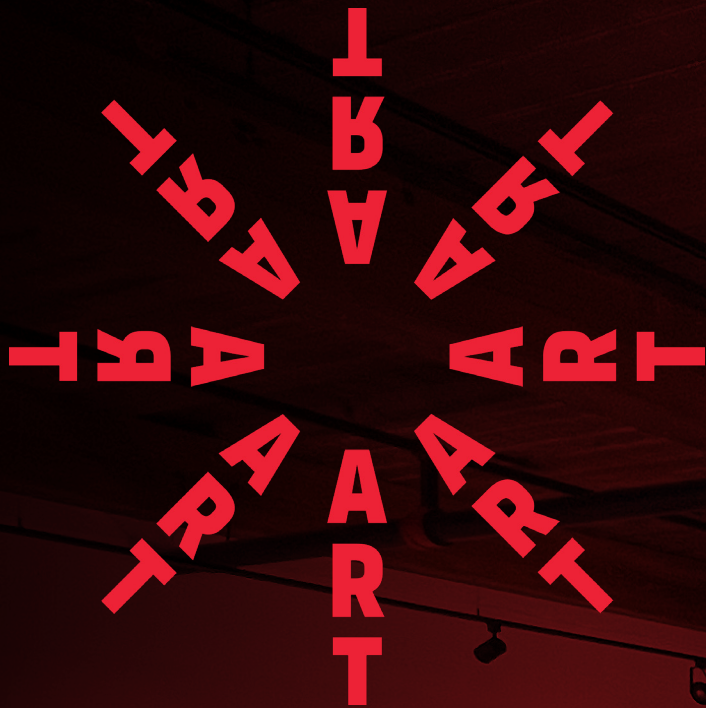


# EXHIBITION & GALLERY

GCCA is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization founded in 2015 by a dedicated group of artists, arts advocates, and community leaders. It is the **only art center of its kind in the Greenville area** specializing in hands-on arts instruction for all ages.

GCCA focuses on creating **accessible arts opportunities** to all in the community including through art classes, affordable artist studios and resources, free public exhibitions, outreach programs like Aspiring Artists for children and young emerging artists, and programs with arts in correctional facilities.

In 2024, GCCA saw over **32,000** visits, with over **6,200** attending First Friday exhibition openings and other events, **23 studio artists**, **1,500** youth and adult program participants, and approximately **300** artists featured in exhibitions. Additionally, GCCA's social media accounts have over **12,000** followers combined, email newsletters are sent to a list of approximately **8,500** subscribers, and over **38,000** unique users visit GCCA's website annually.

**We strive to make art accessible to all through free galleries open year round as well as hyper local and nationwide artists featured in the various galleries.**

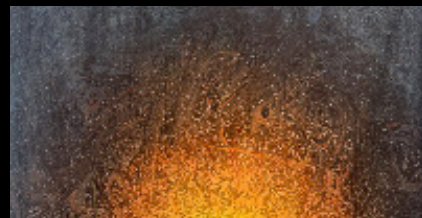

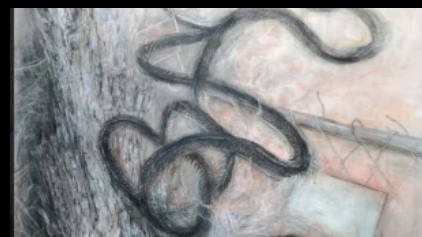
